Solution to **CROSSWORD** :



Solving the clues and arranging the answers to fit in the grid yields the above configuration; the resulting black squares draw the letter **U**.

Solution to **METAPUZZLE** :

The six puzzles this term each gave a single letter answer -- together those letters yield the metapuzzle. If you sort the puzzles alphabetically by title, you get:

- Bridges **G**
- Crossword **U**
- Cryptic Clues **I**
- Fillomino **N**
- Nonogram **E**
- Word Search **A**

This gives the final answer to this term's Fiat Enigma puzzle series: **GUINEA**.

This answer refers to an 18th century British coin, in tribute to the MIT and Berkeley mystery hunts. Traditionally, the final goal of such hunts has been to find a coin hidden on campus; recently this has expanded to include an arbitrary hidden object, still called "the coin."
