

Cryptic crossword clues are split into two parts: a definition of the answer vou're looking for, and another way to construct the answer through wordplay. These parts can come in either order. Some examples of cryptic constructions:

· Anagram: A clue may be the anagrammed letters of the answer; this is hinted with words like "wild" or "drunk." Ex: "Tarnation!" snarled Pulp Fiction director." The answer TARANTINO ("Pulp Fiction director") comes from the snarled letters of "Tarnation."
