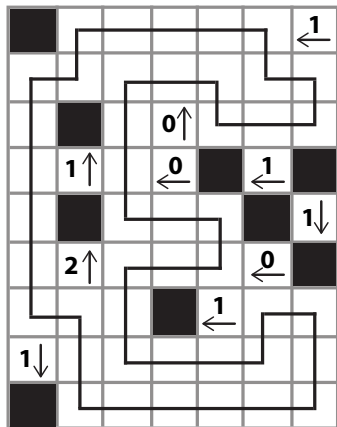


Solution to ARROW LINK:

When the puzzle is completed according to the given rules, the closed path forms the letter E.
