

Within the grid there are 6 words, each 8 characters long that wrap around to form a box. The fact that the words wrap around and are not in a straight line is hinted by the title of the puzzle. The six words are: Aperture, Blowhole, Catacomb, Dungeon, Enclosed, and Foothold. Each of the six words encircles a single letter, and when those letters are ordered alphabetically by the surrounding word you get the answer "RECESS".
