### Solution to Food Court:

The title of the puzzle hints at a food theme. Each clue phrase is a slightly modified restaurant slogan. The restaurant name is clued by the enumerations. For example "What You Crate (5,6)" is a modified version of "What You Crave" the slogan for White Castle. The flavor text hints at tracking the number of changes made to the slogans. In this case there was only a single change, a "V" was changed to a "T". Indexing 1 letter into the restaurant name yields a "W". Repeating this process yields the final clue phrase "WE HAVE THE MEATS" which is a slogan for ARBYS, the final answer.
