

Solution to Hindbrain in 1953:

Cutting out the origami and folding it according to the fold key and the number order yields an origami "top" (a shirt) with the partial answer phrase TOP showing at the collar.



One paint-by-number grid, when completed, yields a shape that is distinctive to an advertisement below "The Woman's Page" section of the paper. The other paint by number grid yields _____ ^R_. (This indicates that you should insert an R.) The small versions of the grids matches the size and positioning of the elements on the actual newspaper page. The word in the ad is "puzzles", giving PUZZLERS for the second half of the answer phrase.
